


involved or want to know more, see John. The Shed raises a lot of money if a good number participate. And it is a good day out (providing it is not wet).



**BEWARE PAYPAL USERS.** You may get an e-mail supposedly from Paypal, advising you of a payment, likely in Euros, to someone you have never heard of. There is a prominent link, <u>Recovery My Account</u>. "If you wish to have this amount recovered....." DON"T click. This is an attempt to access you Paypal a/c. . If you have linked your Paypal a/c to your bank a/c or credit card, the risk is increased. **Any** e-mail that you don't recognise, look at the "From" line at the top. This will be something strange and likely not .au. which indicates it came from some foreign country. These scammers are getting more and more clever. **BEWARE STRANGE E-MAIL**
