Alice Springs

Just had 5 days in Alice Springs & tried to make contact with the local men's shed group. We used Mr Google to find the group via head office in Newcastle, only to be given an old address -they had relocated to the showground, 2 years ago. We went to the area where there were a lot of sheds but I managed to find someone else working & they gave me the president's phone no. I rang but had to leave a message but had no reply so I tried once more today Friday, & I got to talk to Richard the president.

He said they meet only on Wednesday night & Sunday nights, so we will miss out on a visit, as we leave tomorrow. Richard did say he still works full time (24hrs) driving a tow truck up to 800klms from his Alice Springs base & on call full time. He said he had been out most of the night to retrieve a chilla from a road train for a great deal of last night & hoped to catch up on a bit of sleep. He went on to say they continue to fund raise to improve their situation for the future.

Palmerston

We will have had a couple of weeks in & around Darwin from mid April through to early June. I took a short visit to the Palmerston men's shed, which is located about 20ks south of Darwin City. Palmerston is a large city suburb & all pretty modern too. Their men's shed is located within the council's local yard & at present is rent free.



As with many sheds they would like

to have bigger premises over & above the 2 basic work bays that currently make up the workshops. Some of their gear consists of a saw mill band saw type (portable) spindle moulder thicknesser saw bench blowers welders etc & a well equipped mechanical area. They also own a large amount of extra equipment & I think that if they had an extra 6 bays they would still need more for their 20 odd members. They said during my visit they firmly believe that they would have many more members if they had the space to lay out the machines - create a "good safe operating space". Their yard area is the same size as their workshop & has a lot of gear in storage too.

They are open 7 days a week with just a handful of guys on site at any one time otherwise they would be constantly falling over each other. Anyway that's it for now, keep it right side up & bye for now.

HELPFUL TIPS
