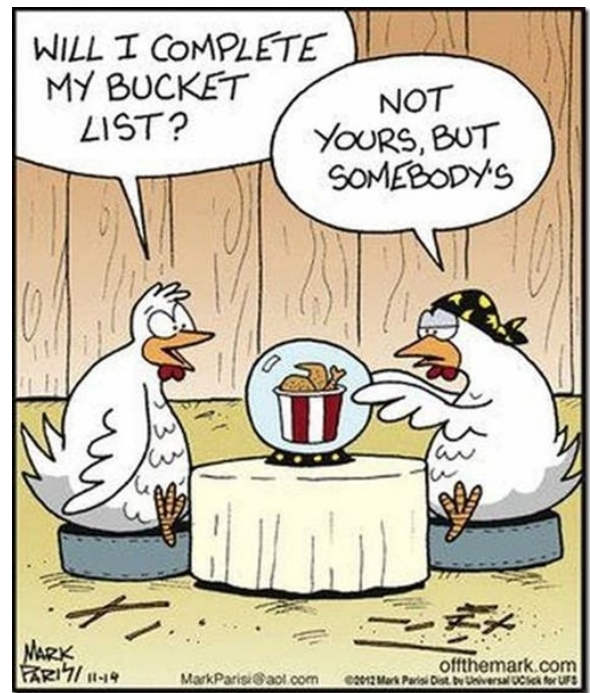
Choir Lunch - Tuesday 8th October.
