### Computer Group.

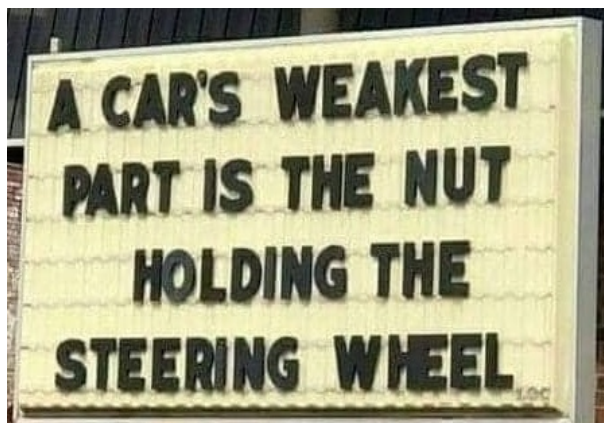
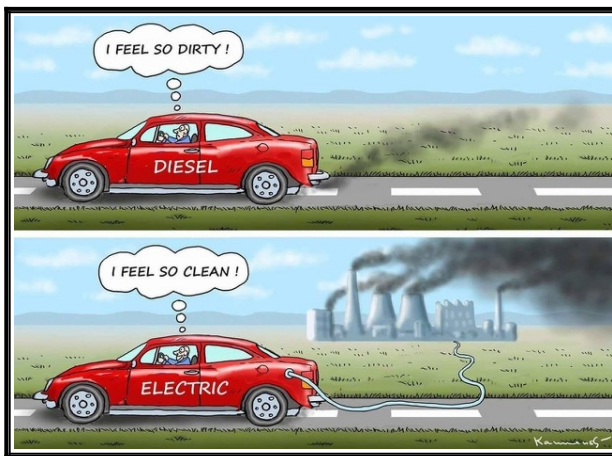
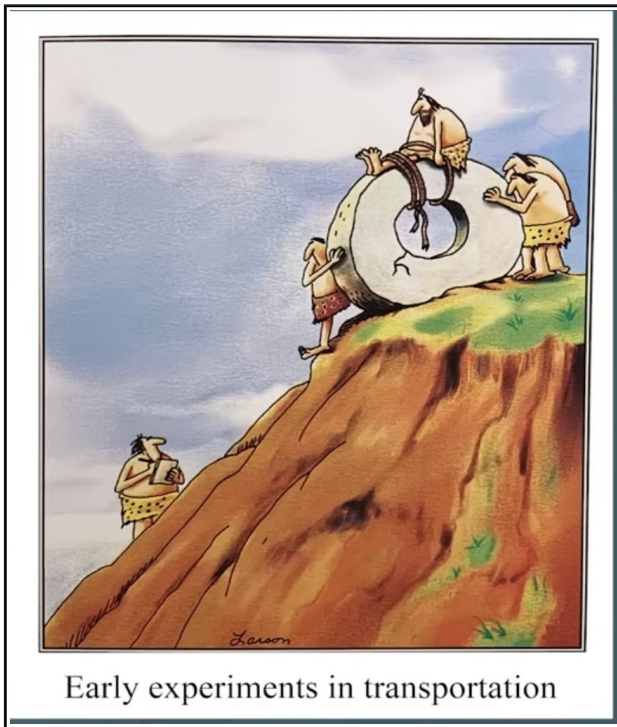
